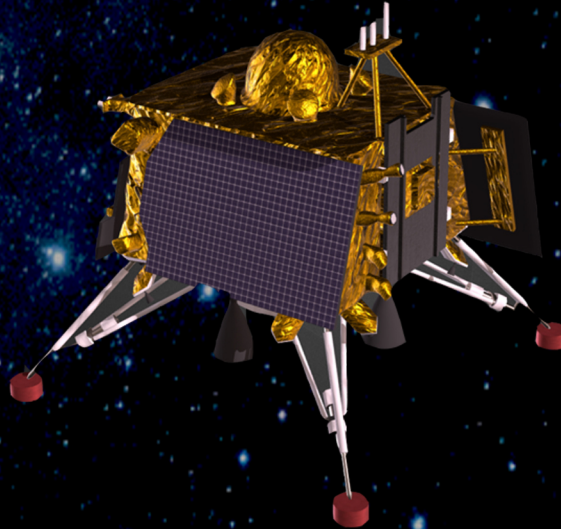

The **Elephant** is native to humid forests in West Africa and Congo Basin. It is the largest mammal on the earth. An elephant's trunk is a long nose used for smelling, breathing, trumpeting, drinking, and grabbing things. Its trunk can hold 2.5 gallons of water and has two-finger features on the end of its trunk. Elephants eat roots, fruits and bark. It consumes up to 100 to 1000 pounds a day. It spends 16 hours per day eating. Elephants travel in a herd. They can communicate with each other over far distances. The elephant is the only mammal that can't jump

Bengal Tigers are native to Bhutan, India and Nepal. Tiger is the largest living cat species. It is more recognisable for its dark vertical stripes on orange fur with a white underside. It belongs to the family Felidae. Its extremely flexible spines and long hind legs, enable them to jump up to 33 feet. It has antiseptic saliva. Tigers are unsocial animals. It seems to enjoy the water and swim well. To survive it needs to live in areas with dense vegetation.
